

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS  
OFFERED BY MR. FORBES OF VIRGINIA**

Mr. Forbes of Virginia moves to recommit the bill H.R. 2647 to the Committee on Armed Services with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith, with the following amendment:

At the end of title X, insert the following new section:

- 1 **SEC. 1055. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR MISSILE DEFENSE**  
2 **AND CERTAIN VEHICLES AND AIRCRAFT.**  
3 (a) FUNDING.—  
4 (1) PROCUREMENT OF AIRCRAFT, ARMY.—The  
5 amount otherwise provided by section 101(1) for  
6 procurement of aircraft, Army, is hereby increased  
7 by \$92,000,000, of which—  
8 (A) \$32,000,000 is to be available for the  
9 procurement of UH-60 Blackhawk helicopters;  
10 and  
11 (B) \$60,000,000 is to be available for the  
12 procurement of CH-47 helicopters.  
13 (2) PROCUREMENT OF WEAPONS AND TRACKED  
14 COMBAT VEHICLES, ARMY.—The amount otherwise

1 provided by section 101(3) for procurement of weap-  
2 ons and tracked combat vehicles, Army, is hereby in-  
3 creased by \$797,800,000, of which—

4 (A) \$138,400,000 is to be available for the  
5 procurement of Stryker vehicles;

6 (B) \$162,400,000 is to be available for the  
7 procurement of High Mobility Multi-Purpose  
8 Wheeled Vehicles;

9 (C) \$197,000,000 is to be available for the  
10 procurement of the family of Medium Tactical  
11 Vehicles; and

12 (D) \$300,000,000 is to be available for the  
13 procurement of Mine Resistant Ambush Pro-  
14 tected, All-Terrain Vehicles.

15 (3) PROCUREMENT OF AIRCRAFT, AIR FORCE.—

16 The amount otherwise provided by section 103(1)  
17 for procurement of aircraft, Air Force, is hereby in-  
18 creased by \$510,200,000, of which—

19 (A) \$110,000,000 is to be available for the  
20 procurement of MQ-9 Unmanned Aerial Vehi-  
21 cles; and

22 (B) \$400,200,000 is to be available for the  
23 procurement of C-130J aircraft.

24 (4) MISSILE DEFENSE.—The amount otherwise  
25 provided by section 201(4) for research, develop-

1 ment, test, and evaluation, Defense-wide, is hereby  
2 increased by \$1,200,000,000 to provide funds for  
3 the Missile Defense Agency, of which—

4 (A) \$600,000,000 is to be available for the  
5 ground-based midcourse defense system;

6 (B) \$237,000,000 is to be available for the  
7 Airborne Laser program;

8 (C) \$177,100,000 is to be available for the  
9 Multiple Kill Vehicle;

10 (D) \$165,900,000 is to be available for the  
11 Kinetic Energy Interceptor; and

12 (E) \$20,000,000 is to be available for the  
13 Space Tracking and Surveillance System.

14 (b) OFFSETTING REDUCTION.—The amount other-  
15 wise provided by section 3102 for defense environmental  
16 cleanup is hereby reduced by \$2,600,000,000, to be de-  
17 rived from sites that are projected to meet regulatory mile-  
18 stones ahead of schedule or are at greatest risk of being  
19 unable to execute Public Law 111–5 and fiscal year 2010  
20 funding as planned for fiscal year 2010.
