

MOTION TO COMMIT H.RES. 5

OFFERED BY MR. DREIER OF CALIFORNIA

Mr. Dreier moves to commit the resolution to a select committee comprised of the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendments:

Page 3, strike lines 1 through 13 (relating to terms of committee chairmen) and redesignate subsections (e) and (f) accordingly.

Page 4, strike lines 13 through 25 (relating to instructions in the motion to recommit) and redesignate succeeding subsections accordingly.

At the end of section 2, insert the following new subsections:

1 (k) FAIRNESS IN COMMITTEE RATIOS.—Clause
2 5(a)(1) of rule X is amended by inserting the following
3 after the first sentence: “With respect to all committees
4 other than the Committee on Rules and the Committee
5 on Standards of Official Conduct, the ratio of majority
6 to minority Members serving on such committees shall re-
7 flect the ratio of majority to minority Members in the
8 House.”

1 (l) ENSURING TRANSPARENCY IN COMMITTEE
2 VOTES.—Clause 2(e)(1)(B)(i) of rule XI is amended to
3 read as follows:

4 “(i) Except as provided in sub-
5 division (B)(ii) and subject to para-
6 graph (k)(7), the result of each such
7 record vote shall be made available by
8 the committee within two business
9 days on the committee’s website and
10 for inspection by the public at reason-
11 able times in its offices. Information
12 so available shall include a description
13 of the amendment, motion, order, or
14 other proposition, the name of each
15 member voting for and each member
16 voting against such amendment, mo-
17 tion, order, or proposition, and the
18 names of those members of the com-
19 mittee present but not voting.”.
