

MOTION TO RECOMMIT

OFFERED BY MRS. BACHMANN OF MINNESOTA

Mrs. Bachmann of Minnesota moves to recommit the bill back to the Committee on Armed services with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following new title:

1 **TITLE _____ —PAY FREEZE**

2 **SEC. ___ 01. PAY FREEZE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
4 sion of law, for purposes of computing compensation for
5 service performed during fiscal year 2011 and the first
6 quarter of fiscal year 2012, the rate of salary or basic
7 pay for any office or position within the civil service, as
8 defined by section 2101 of title 5, United States Code,
9 shall be deemed to be equal to the rate of salary or basic
10 pay payable for such office or position as of September
11 30, 2010.

12 (b) CONGRESSIONAL PAY FREEZE.—Notwith-
13 standing any other provision of law, no adjustment shall
14 be made under section 601(a) of the Legislative Reorga-
15 nization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31) (related to the Com-
16 pensation of Members of Congress) during fiscal year
17 2011 and the first quarter of fiscal year 2012.

1 (c) RULE FOR NEW POSITIONS.—For purposes of
2 subsection (a), the rate of salary or basic pay payable as
3 of September 30, 2010, for any office or position which
4 was not in existence on such date shall be deemed to be
5 the rate of salary or basic pay payable to individuals in
6 comparable offices or positions on such date.

7 (d) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
8 tion shall be considered to apply with respect to any office
9 or position within the uniformed services, as defined by
10 section 2101 of title 5, United States Code.
