

MOTION TO RECOMMIT
OFFERED BY MR. THOMPSON OF PENNSYLVANIA

Mr. Thompson of Pennsylvania moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 2187, to the Committee on Education and Labor with instructions to report the bill back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

In section 311, add at the end the following:

1 (c) LIMITATION.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections
3 (a) and (b) and any other provision of this Act, for
4 any fiscal year for which funds are authorized to be
5 appropriated under this Act that immediately follows
6 a fiscal year in which the Federal Government has
7 a deficit in excess of \$500,000,000,000, the amount
8 authorized to be appropriated under this Act shall
9 be \$0.

10 (2) DEFINITION.—For the purpose of this sub-
11 section, the term “deficit” means a fiscal year dur-
12 ing which outlays of the Federal Government exceed
13 receipts of the Federal Government.
