

MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 1145
OFFERED BY MR. NUNES OF CALIFORNIA

Mr. Nunes moves to recommit the bill H.R. 1145 to the Committee on Science and Technology with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith in the form to which perfected at the time of this motion, with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. ____ . REPORTS TO CONGRESS.**

2 (a) REPORT ON BARRIERS.—Not later than 90 days
3 after the date of enactment of this Act, the President shall
4 submit to Congress a report that—

5 (1) identifies from each agency on the inter-
6 agency committee established under section 2(b) the
7 statutory or regulatory barriers—

8 (A) that prevent the use of technology,
9 technique, data collection method, or model con-
10 sidered under this Act; and

11 (B) that, due to such barrier to using such
12 technology, technique, method, or model, con-
13 tribute to the loss of jobs in rural or agricul-

1 tural economies dependent on the greater avail-
2 ability of water resources in the United States;

3 (2) identifies the long-term consequences on job
4 losses of such barriers that continue to be in effect;
5 and

6 (3) recommends steps to remove such barriers.

7 (b) REPORT ON IMPACTS.—Not later than 90 days
8 after the date of enactment of this Act, the President shall
9 submit to Congress a report that—

10 (1) identifies the economic impacts of water di-
11 versions for water supply, conservation for fish spe-
12 cies (including the Delta smelt), and water quality
13 impairment in the San Joaquin Valley of California;
14 and

15 (2) recommends steps to mitigate such eco-
16 nomic impacts to preserve the water-dependent rural
17 economy.
