

AMENDMENT TO H. RES. 1509
OFFERED BY MS. FOXX OF NORTH CAROLINA

At the end of the resolution add the following new section:

1 Sec. 4. Immediately upon the adoption of this resolu-
2 tion the Speaker shall, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule
3 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
4 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 5679) to prevent funding from the
6 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 from
7 being used for physical signage indicating that a project
8 is funded by such Act, and for other purposes. The first
9 reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of
10 order against consideration of the bill are waived. General
11 debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed
12 one hour equally divided and controlled by the Majority
13 Leader and the Minority Leader or their respective des-
14 ignees. After general debate the bill shall be considered
15 for amendment under the five-minute rule. During consid-
16 eration of the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the
17 Committee of the Whole may accord priority in recognition
18 on the basis of whether the Member offering an amend-
19 ment has caused it to be printed in the portion of the Con-

1 gressional Record designated for that purpose in clause
2 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be consid-
3 ered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill
4 for amendment the Committee shall rise and report the
5 bill to the House with such amendments as may have been
6 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-
7 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage
8 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit
9 with or without instructions. If the Committee of the
10 Whole rises and reports that it has come to no resolution
11 on the bill, then on the next legislative day the House
12 shall, immediately after the third daily order of business
13 under clause 1 of rule XIV, resolve into the Committee
14 of the Whole for further consideration of the bill. Clause
15 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to the consideration of
16 H.R. 5679.
