

MOTION TO COMMIT WITH INSTRUCTIONS

Mr. Barton of Texas moves to commit the bill (S. 352) to the Committee on Energy and Commerce with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6. CLEARANCE OF PUBLIC SAFETY SPECTRUM, ADJA-**
2 **CENT CHANNELS, AND OTHER CHANNELS**
3 **CAUSING INTERFERENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, any
5 amendments made by this Act, or any revision to any rule,
6 regulation, or order pursuant to this Act or such amend-
7 ments, no full-power television broadcast station shall be
8 permitted, after February 17, 2009, to continue broad-
9 casting—

10 (1) in the television service on channels 63, 64,
11 68, or 69 (764-806 megahertz, inclusive);

12 (2) on any channels adjacent to the channels
13 described in paragraph (1), if cessation of broad-
14 casting on such channels is determined by the Fed-
15 eral Communications Commission to be necessary to

1 prevent interference with public safety communica-
2 tions; and

3 (3) on any other channel, if cessation of broad-
4 casting on such channel is determined by the Fed-
5 eral Communications Commission to be necessary to
6 ensure that—

7 (A) all public safety radio service licensees
8 can relocate onto and begin operation on their
9 respective licensed spectrum; or

10 (B) no full-power television broadcast sta-
11 tion is subject to unacceptable interference or
12 has its coverage area significantly reduced.
