## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1333 OFFERED BY MR. WENSTRUP OF OHIO

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1	SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.
2	(a) In General.—This Act, and the amendments
3	made by this Act, shall not take effect until the date on
4	which every alien described in subsection (b) is required
5	to produce to the Transportation Security Administration
6	proof of a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) test com-
7	pleted not earlier than 24 hours before the alien attempts
8	to board a domestic flight in the United States.
9	(b) Aliens Described.—An alien is described in
10	this subsection if the alien—
11	(1) is inadmissible to the United States under
12	section 212(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
13	Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a));
14	(2) was encountered by U.S. Customs and Bor-
15	der Protection on or after January 20, 2021;
16	(3) was released by U.S. Customs and Border
17	Protection after such encounter; and
18	(4) is traveling by plane to a final destination
19	in the United States.

- 1 (c) Report.—Notwithstanding section 4(a)(1), and
- 2 in accordance with subsection (a), the report required
- 3 under section 4(a)(1) shall not be required to be submitted
- 4 until the date that is 90 days after the effective date under
- 5 subsection (a).
