

1 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Upon receiving information
2 that Israel is under an existing or imminent threat
3 of military attack, the President may waive the re-
4 quirements of this Act and direct the immediate
5 transfer to Israel of such defense articles or defense
6 services the President determines to be necessary to
7 assist Israel in its defense against such threat.
8 Amounts obligated or expended to carry out this
9 paragraph shall not be subject to any limitation in
10 law, or provision of any bilateral agreement, relating
11 to the amount of United States assistance author-
12 ized to be made available to Israel.

13 “(2) NOTIFICATION REQUIRED.—As soon as
14 practicable after a transfer of defense articles or de-
15 fense services pursuant to the authority provided by
16 paragraph (1), the President shall provide a notifica-
17 tion in writing to Congress of the details of such
18 transfer, consistent with the requirements of section
19 36 of this Act.”.
