18	Office of Management and Budget shall provide a report

20	resentatives and the Senate three days after enactment of

- 7 further, That none of the funds appropriated or made

- 11 mula shortage or the Commissioner submits to the Com-
- 12 mittees on Appropriations of the House of Representatives
