

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 3771**

**OFFERED BY M\_\_\_\_.** \_\_\_\_\_

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 4. REPORT ON THE COVID-19 EDUCATION CRISIS IN**  
2 **PUBLIC SCHOOLS.**

3 Not later than 6 months after the date of enactment  
4 of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human Services  
5 shall provide to Congress a report on the COVID-19 edu-  
6 cation crisis in public schools during the period between  
7 March 1, 2020, and March 1, 2022. Such report shall in-  
8 clude—

9 (1) the average number of days elementary and  
10 secondary education schools were closed to in-person  
11 classroom instruction;

12 (2) the average amount of time intended for in-  
13 person classroom instruction that was lost;

14 (3) the participation rates in remote-learning  
15 programs;

16 (4) the impact of school closures on children,  
17 including the disproportionate impact on children in  
18 low-income, disadvantaged, or vulnerable commu-  
19 nities, with regard to—

20 (A) academic achievement;

1 (B) mental health and well-being; and

2 (C) social development;

3 (5) a detailed accounting of the Centers for  
4 Disease Control and Prevention’s decision-making  
5 process and data used for the creation of the “Oper-  
6 ational Guidance for K–12 Schools and Early Care  
7 and Education Programs to Support Safe In-Person  
8 Learning’”; and

9 (6) a detailed accounting of unspent Federal  
10 dollars directed to school districts that were author-  
11 ized by the American Rescue Plan Act.
